Training partnerships

A key strategy for JASANZ is to support the improvement of conformity assessment performance with high-quality training through the JASANZ Accelerate Training Academy. These collaborations with scheme owners to train Conformity Assessment Bodies (CABs) and certified or yet to be certified organisations meets our goal of improving knowledge and expertise in conformity assessment including accreditation and certification.

Partnering with MBIE

In late 2022, JASANZ partnered with the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) in New Zealand to develop and deliver training in the updated CodeMark New Zealand scheme. The scheme is a voluntary product certification scheme that provides an easily-understood and robust way to show a building product or building method meets the requirements of the New Zealand Building Code.

Training was for Product Certification Bodies (PCBs), certificate holders and JASANZ assessors. A training package was developed and delivered invluding an online module, live webinars, and assessment for PCBs to confirm their understanding of the scheme. Certificate holders attended a webinar on the updates to the scheme.

Training was provided to 46 PCB auditors and 60 certification holders.

Partnering with NDIS

JASANZ recently partnered with the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) to develop and deliver training in the alignment of the NDIS and aged care provider regulatory frameworks for NDIS and residential aged care (RAC) providers who also deliver support to NDIS participants.

The training was delivered including a number of live webinars, presented in conjunction with the NDIS Quality and Safeguards Commission, for Approved Quality Auditors (AQAs) accredited by JASANZ to the scheme. In addition, course marterials and an assessment were set for AQAs to complete to ensure they understood the changes to the scheme.

Training was provided to more than 160 auditors in the updated scheme.

Partnering with FAMI-QS

JASANZ is proud to continue our partnership with FAMI-QS to provide a customised training program in conformity assessment and management system certification for the organisations that have applied for FAMI-QS certification. We are also providing training to all Conformity Assessment Bodies (CABs) applying for FAMI-QS accreditation.


FAMI-QS is an accredited third-party feed safety management system for the sector of specialty feed ingredients and their mixtures. FAMI-QS has been part of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) since 2017. FAMI-QS sees accreditation as an important pillar for the credibility of its scheme and the certification process.

JASANZ has developed and delivers training in conformity assessment and Management System Certification (ISO/IEC 17021-1) for the applicant organisations globally. CABs are trained in the ISO/IEC 17021-1 Management System Certification standard and additional requirements of the FAMI-QS Scheme.

Partnering with PEFC

In 2021, JASANZ partnered with PEFC Asia-Pacific to provide training in accreditation standards as part of PEFC's work with the UN-REDD Programme Initiative 'Sustainable Forest Trade in the Lower Mekong Region'. We delivered training in ISO/IEC 17021-1 Management System Certification and ISO/IEC 17065 Product Certification for Accreditation and Certification Bodies in Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Vietnam and Indonesia.

The Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) is a key service provider for the UN-REDD Initiative "Sustainable Forest Trade in the Lower Mekong Region (LMR)". The aim is to promote trade and sustainable forest management (SFM) through improved governance in Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand and Vietnam. The initiative was funded by the Government of Norway and is implemented by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP). Key outcomes include the development of forest certification schemes and related quality infrastructure mechanisms. PEFC will build on the framework of its For-Trade Initiative, which is sustainable forestry and trade for development in the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).

Course overview

ISO/IEC 17065:2012 Conformity assessment - Requirements for bodies certifying products, processes and services is an International Standard that provides Certification Bodies with requirements for the certification of products, processes and services.

The overall aim of certifying products, processes or services is to give confidence to all interested parties that a product, process or service fulfils specified requirements. The value of certification is the degree of confidence and trust that is established by an impartial and competent demonstration of fulfilment of specified requirements by a third party. Parties that have an interest in certification include, but are not limited to:

- a) the clients of the certification bodies:
- b) the customers of the organisations whose products, processes or services are certified;
- c) governmental authorities;
- d) non-governmental organisations; and
- e) consumers and other members of the public.

Course overview

ISO/IEC 17021-1:2015 Conformity assessment - Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems is an International Standard providing Certification Bodies with requirements for the certification of management systems.

Certification of a management system, such as the environmental management system, quality management system or information security management system of an organisation, is one means of providing assurance that the organisation has implemented a system for the management of the relevant aspects of its activities, products and services, in line with the organisation's policy and the requirements of the respective international management system standard.

This part of ISO/IEC 17021 specifies requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems. It gives generic requirements for such bodies performing audit and certification in the field of quality, the environment and other types of management systems. Observance of these requirements is intended to ensure that certification bodies operate management system certification in a competent, consistent and impartial manner, thereby facilitating the recognition of such bodies and the acceptance of their certifications on a national and international basis. This part of ISO/IEC 17021 serves as a foundation for facilitating the recognition of management system certification in the interests of international trade.

Course overview

ISO/IEC 17020:2012 Conformity assessment - Requirements for the operation of various types of bodies performing inspection is an International Standard that provides inspection bodies (IBs) with the requirements for impartial and consistent inspections.

Inspection bodies carry out assessments on behalf of private clients, their parent organisations, or authorities, with the objective of providing information about the conformity of inspected items with regulations, standards, specifications, inspection schemes or contracts. Inspection parameters include matters of quantity, quality, safety, fitness for purpose, and continued safety compliance of installations or systems in operation. The general requirements with which these bodies are required to comply in order that their services are accepted by clients and by supervisory authorities are harmonised in this International Standard.

This International Standard covers the activities of inspection bodies whose work can include the examination of materials, products, installations, plants, processes, work procedures or services, and the determination of their conformity with requirements and the subsequent reporting of results of these activities to clients and, when required, to authorities. Inspection can concern all stages during the lifetime of these items, including the design stage. This International Standard can be used as a requirements document for accreditation or peer assessment or other assessments.

Course overview

The ISO/IEC 17029 Conformity assessment - General principles and requirements for validation and verification bodies standard features conformity assessment concepts for validation and verification.

Validation and verification as conformity assessment are understood to be a confirmation of reliability of information declared in claims. Other terms in use for the object of assessment by validation and verification are "statement", "declaration", "assertion", "prediction" or "report".

Both activities are distinguished according to the timeline of the assessed claim. Validation is applied to claims regarding an intended future use or projected outcome (confirmation of plausibility), while verification is applied to claims regarding events that have already occurred or results that have already been obtained (confirmation of truthfulness).

Gourse overview

ISO 14065:2020 General principles and requirements for bodies validating and verifying environmental information is an International Standard that provides validation and verification bodies (VVBs), with a set of requirements that enables them to undertake the validation and verification of environmental information.

Environmental information, including statements and claims, are increasingly being used for decision-making by individuals and organisations. Users of environmental information want to know whether it is accurate and reliable. This Standard identifies principles and defines requirements for validation and verification bodies.


